# **Attracting and Developing Talent**

Since one cannot pour from an empty cup, Kujawa Primary underscores the importance of teachers continuously expanding their knowledge to provide enriching student experiences. Their extensive partnership with the International Baccalaureate program ensures teachers not only benefit from knowledge-rich curricula like Amplify CKLA at the district level and receive additional training through the IB program. ### Play: Learning to Love Learning

Student ambassadors, aged six, led the first part of our tour and were eager to share the Oral Language Lab—a museum-like set of curated stations connected to literature—and the library. **The coherence of knowledge-building was striking**; posters of plants, drawings, and student-nurtured seedlings were everywhere, adding to the fun atmosphere. Children actively participated in discussions at various centers or with teachers, displaying a welcoming attitude as they proudly showcased their work to us as visitors.





### **Strong Academic Foundations**

Knowledge-building is fundamental at Kujawa Primary. Through Amplify CKLA Pre-K, content walls, displayed vocabulary, and examples of student work related to various subjects, it's clear that children are learning about their world and expanding their vocabulary while engaging in discussions. This knowledge is shared systematically through the IB transdisciplinary thematic units of inquiry, which explore topics like "Sharing our Planet."
